1.1 BEC- Technical:

1.1.1 The bidder must have executed & completed at least Three (03) order/contract/Agreement each of not less than Rs 47.35 Lakhs of "similar nature of work" in previous seven (07) years to be reckoned from the due date of unpriced bid opening

OR

The bidder must have executed & completed at least Two (02) orders/contracts each of not less than Rs 59.19 Lakh of "similar nature of work" in previous seven (07) years to be reckoned from the due date of unpriced bid opening

OR

The bidder must have executed & completed at least one (01) similar order/contract of not less than Rs 94.71 Lakh of "similar nature of work" in previous seven (07) years to be reckoned from the due date of unpriced bid opening

Note 1:

- a) Bidder(s) shall be required to submit the documents in respect of above experience criteria as per details at sl. no. 1.3 below.
- b) Definition of "similar nature of work": Providing service assistance for various operational related activities such as plant commissioning /start up /shutdown /normal plant operation at Petrochemical Plant/ Fertilizer Plant/Petroleum Refinery/ Chemical Plant/ Gas Processing Complex/ LP G Plant".

1.1.2. In case of running contract for 'the job' as mentioned at sl. no. 1.1.1 above, the contract VALUE executed till one day prior to due date of bid submission is equal to or more than the minimum prescribed VALUE mentioned above at BEC clause no. 1.1.1, such experience will also be taken into consideration provided that the bidder has submitted satisfactory work execution certificate issued by the end user / owner / authorized consultant.

1.2. BEC- Financial:

1.2.1 TURN OVER:

The bidder should have Average annual turnover of Rs. 59.19 Lakh as per the audited financial result (Balance sheet and profit & Loss account statement) in the preceding three (03) financial years (FY: 2024-25, 2023-24, 2022-23).

1.2.2 NET WORTH:

Net Worth of the bidder should be positive as per the last audited financial statement i.e. FY: 2024-25.

1.2.3 WORKING CAPITAL:

The bidder should have minimum working capital of value Rs 11.84 Lakh as per the last audited financial statement for the year i.e. the financial year 2024-25.

Note 2:

- i) *If the bidder's working capital is negative or inadequate as per BEC clause no. 1.2.3, the bidder shall submit/upload a letter from the bidder's bank as per Format F-9 having net worth not less than Rs.100 crores, confirming the availability of line of credit for requisite amount as mentioned above at BEC clause no. 1.2.3 to meet the working capital (Format specified in tender document). Document issued on or before bid due date shall be considered for evaluation. Any F-9 received after bid due date shall not be considered for evaluation. Original F-9 has to be submitted by bidder within 7 days from the date of opening of un-price bid opening.*

RELAXATION OF PRIOR TURNOVER AND PRIOR EXPERIENCE FOR STARTUPS (AS DEFINED IN GAZETTE NOTIFICATION NO. D.L-33004/99 DATED 18.02.2016 AND 23.05.2017 OF MINISTRY OF COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY), AS AMENDED TIME TO TIME

Prior turnover and prior experience as mentioned above in financial and technical criteria of BEC shall not be required for all Startups [whether Micro & Small Enterprises (MSEs) or otherwise] subject to their meeting the quality and technical specifications specified in tender document.

For availing the relaxation, bidder is required to submit requisite certificate towards Startup enterprise registration issued by Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT), Ministry of Commerce & Industry and relaxation is to be given to the specific goods / jobs domain wherein they are registered for.

Wherever the "Certificate of Recognition" is stipulating the domain of startup, the domain of startup is to be considered based "Certificate of Recognition" issued by Department of Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT). Startups having the "Certificate of Recognition" which do not mention Domain, in such case startups are also required to submit the documents for the same including the application submitted to DPIIT.

New startup "Certificate of Recognition" is stipulating "Industry" and "Sector" as domain of startup. Accordingly, "Industry" and "Sector" as domain of startups mentioned in certificate/ application (in case of old certificate which do not indicate domain) will be considered.

The above documents should be certified by the Chartered Accountant (not being an employee or a Director or not having any interest in the bidder's company/firm) and notary public with legible stamp.

2.0 Methodology for Evaluation of Bids & Award:

2.1 BCPL will evaluate and compare the Price bids of the technically qualified bidders whose bids are previously determined to be substantially responsive pursuant to "ITB: Clause-29". For the purpose of evaluation of bid and arriving at the L1 bidder for award, the total value of SORs on overall basis shall be considered including GST .

2.2 In case of a tie at the lowest bid (L1) position between two or more bidders, then evaluation shall be done as per GEM .

2.3 CPBG: The following CPBG clause shall be incorporated in tender document,

The contract performance security shall be 5% of annualized Basic Contract Value (without GST therein)

OR

Initial security deposit (ISD) @ 2.5% of Total Order /Contract value. in case contract period is less than one year or 2.5% of Annualized Order / Contract value in case contract period is more than one year within 30 days of FOA/notification of award and deduction @ 2.5% of the RA bill subsequently from RA bills till the total amount of security deposit (including ISD and deducted amount) reaches 5% of Total Order / Contract value in case contract period is less than one year or 5% of Annualized Order / Contract value in case con

tract period is more than one year.

2.4 PPP Policy 2012:

Considering the nature of job, splitting of quantities will not be possible in this case and hence the clause for award of 25 % of ordered quantity to MSE as per PPP 2012 is not possible. Therefore, MSE quoting price within price band and L1 (other than MSE) + 15%, may be awarded for full / complete services of tendered value subject to matching of L1 price as per ITB of tender document. In case two or more MSE bidders come within the price band of L1 + 15%, the preference to match the L1 rate shall be given in sequence of their inter-se position (L2, L3... and so on). In case of tie, the MSE bidder having highest turnover shall be awarded subject to matching of L1 price”.

6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
7. Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.

8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process. (However, in bids for [attached categories](#), trials are allowed as per approved procurement policy of the buyer nodal Ministries)
9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.
15. Any ATC clause in contravention with GeM GTC Clause 4 (xiii)(h) will be invalid. In case of multiple L1 bidders against a service bid, the buyer shall place the Contract by selection of a bidder amongst the L-1 bidders through a Random Algorithm executed by GeM system.

17. In a category based bid, adding additional items, through buyer added additional scope of work/ additional terms and conditions/or any other document. If buyer needs more items along with the main item, the same must be added through bunching category based items or by bunching custom catalogs or bunching a BoQ with the main category based item, the same must not be done through ATC or Scope of Work.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.

All GeM Sellers / Service Providers are mandated to ensure compliance with all the applicable laws / acts / rules including but not limited to all Labour Laws such as The Minimum Wages Act, 1948, The Payment of Wages Act, 1936, The Payment of Bonus Act, 1965, The Equal Remuneration Act, 1976, The Payment of Gratuity Act, 1972 etc. Any non-compliance will be treated as breach of contract and Buyer may take suitable actions as per GeM Contract.
